COUNCILWOMAN JANICE HAHN FORMALLY ACCEPTS LAND FOR NEW HARBOR GATEWAY COMMUNITY CENTER

City Formally Accepts Land Moves Project Forward

The Los Angeles City Council, at the urging of Councilwoman Janice Hahn, has formally accepted donated land for a new community center in Harbor Gateway. The vacant lot, located at Denker Avenue and Del Amo Boulevard, is in the neighborhood where 14 year-old Cheryl Green was shot and killed last December. The Councilwoman met with representatives of REMCO, who owned the property, earlier this year and secured the donation.

“Colleagues, accepting this land provides some good news for a Harbor Gateway neighborhood that needs it,” said the Councilwoman during the meeting. “Working with this community, we identified this site for a much-needed youth center. Today, we are one step closer to having a safe facility for them.”

Now that acquisition is complete, design and construction of the community center will begin, with completion expected by mid-2008.
